Mr. Limrite is known for creating works of dramatic depth and cathartic expressionism. You will be asked to conceive of new ways of presenting your work.

David Limrite was born in Salinas, California. He studied at San Diego State University and the Art Center College of Design in Pasadena. He served as the Art Director in the editorial department at the Los Angeles Herald Examiner where he began to understand the dramatic impact of the tragic pictorial imagery he constantly encountered. He would apply these characteristics to his own emotional and dramatic drawings.



Mr. Limrite's studio and home are in La Crescenta, CA. He taught drawing and painting at Art Center College of Design for 12 years and is in his 18th year of teaching at Brentwood Art Center where he is currently the Director of Education.
